Nearly six decades ago, God chose the Charter Members of LCC to do His work in our community. Over the years, our church has helped thousands come to know Christ through its many ministries, and now we have inherited this great legacy and have been chosen to carry it forward. As times have changed, so have the spiritual needs of those in our community, and we continue to strive to meet these evolving needs and to keep the LCC story growing.

Our alternative second service and the live streaming of our traditional service now reach many individuals and families that otherwise might not hear the Lord's message on Sundays. With a new Youth and Family Director, we have refocused this area of ministry on engaging young family participation and seek to interact more with the Day School students and their families, as well as their new leadership. Our focus in the coming year is to keep building on these initiatives and to continue to meet the challenges and opportunities of our changing culture. As part of Christ's universal, eternal church, our mission is to keep our story as a Church Family growing, and to bring God's words of faith to the current and future generations in our community.

Sustaining and Growing Our Story

Viewed in the context of our church's story and its longterm missions, financial giving to LCC is about much more than just paying next year's bills. It is about building upon and extending the foundations of our legacy of bringing faith alive to those in our community for many years to come. Like the centuries-old cathedrals of Europe that took decades to build, our church's story and the intent of next year's giving have a decidedly long-term time horizon.

As those who have been chosen to sustain and grow the LCC story into the future, our stewardship commitments to LCC are an investment in God's plan for its ministries. Just as Christ was "*all in*" in His commitment to us, we are called to trust in God and to be *all in* in meeting the stewardship needs necessary for fulfillment of these plans.

To continue to grow our story in 2024, we estimate that our overall budget needs will increase by \$27,000, or 4.5%, in the coming year. Our Church Family has been blessed with outstanding and dedicated leadership and support staff, who contribute much to our story, and it is incumbent upon all of us to consider their needs, both personally as well as in the context of their work efforts at LCC, as each of us considers our individual stewardship commitments for 2024.

Faithfully Living Our Story

Stewardship extends well beyond faithful giving to include *Faithful Living*, as God's interest in our lives includes what we do with <u>all</u> of the gifts He has given to us – time and talents, and not just treasures. As has been so inspiringly evident over our history, the LCC story going forward will in large measure reflect our congregants' living faithfully with an *all in* commitment to serving our ministries.

Our pastors and staff rely heavily upon the active participation of congregants to supplement their efforts, and growing our story forward in the coming years will require an increased commitment of <u>time and talents</u> by the members of our Church Family. Many opportunities for participation are available, and we hope that everyone will consider their <u>time and talents</u>, along with their treasures, in their *all-in* 2024 stewardship commitment to live faithfully.
